Awards Committee

Kathy Dixon, from Ochsner Health System was chosen as the 2014 Outstanding Coordinator.

Archives Committee

The goal will be to have a slide show of photos from past meetings displayed during our evening receptions. Also this committee has been appointed the association's photographer for all APCR meetings and events.

Fellowship Ad Hoc Committee

The goal for this committee is to be able to discuss with one another on ways we can improve our fellowship programs, prepare ourselves for upcoming changes/challenges and overall network between one another.

Finance Committee

As of June 2015, the total liabilities and net assets of the APCR are \$465,947.

Long Range Planning Committee

The Committee will again organize social events for APCR members during the AUR. Last year, a dinner and haunted walking tour were well-received. All members pay their own way, but the Committee coordinates the events.

Membership Committee

As of October 2015, the APCR membership is at 187. We have been hovering around 190 for a while. Our goal is to have 200 members by the 2016 AUR by targeting Radiology Fellowship Coordinators.



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Mentoring Committee

The Mentoring Committee continues to work with the Membership Committee to pair new members with mentors. The purpose of the Committee is to provide networking opportunities and promote career development. There are 16 members of the Committee. The mentoring and membership committees are planning to host a meet and greet event at the AUR meeting for new APCR members. We are also planning to have our 2nd annual boot camp workshop session for our new coordinators at the AUR.

Professional Development Committee

The committee prepares quarterly newsletters for the membership. Members are asked to submit newsworthy items prior to the publication dates. Projects the PDC members are working on include: job descriptions for coordinators, working with the Long Range Planning committee on the handbook for coordinators and Certificates of Attendance to APCR members who attend AUR sessions.

Program Planning Committee

The Program Planning Committee has produced another very exciting agenda for our upcoming meeting in San Diego. It will include guest speakers from the ACGME, APCR and ERAS. Some topics for our APCR sessions will include ACGME Update for Program Coordinators, Lessons Learned from the Self-Study Process: Pearls and Pitfalls and ERAS Update. The society welcome reception will once again be held on the Monday evening prior to the start of the meeting. The APCR will also continue to host two member lunches as well as a dedicated session for new program coordinators/administrators on Wed morning.

RRC Committee

The Committee continues to work with the Program Directors Support Committee on matters concerning Program Directors and Program Coordinators and ACGME issues.

Rules Committee

As of March 2015, there have been no proposed changes to the Rules of Operation.

The Committee will continue to review the Rules of Operation and make recommendations to the President as necessary.



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Scholarship Committee

The scholarship award is currently \$2,000.00 and only awarded to APCR members. The committee extended the scholarship deadline but did not receive any applications for this year.

Survey Committee

Since the AUR Annual Meeting, the Survey Committee has reviewed 7 surveys and approved/distributed five surveys: Evaluation of 2015 APCR Sessions; Moonlighting for Residents; Residency Program Benefits; Survey of Non-Interpretive Skills for the Radiology Resident; Wintrop University Hospital Resident Trainee Survey. The results of closed surveys are posted to the APCR website.

TAGME Certification

There are currently 26 TAGME certified coordinators. Since the 2015 AUR Meeting, 6 coordinators have either recertified or are newly certified.

Electronic Communications Committee

We currently have 82 APCR members that have joined the LinkedIn group. While the discussion board remains active, it appears the volume of postings has declined.

One major goal this year is to develop a smart phone app for the AUR Conference, featuring all the APCR activities. We plan to use Yapp. We will be working on getting this functional in the months leading up to AUR.
