# Call for Applications: Diversity Away Elective in Oncologic Imaging

Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York City is seeking a highly motivated 2nd-year radiology resident (PGY-3) from an underrepresented background in medicine and radiology to participate in a one-month, in-person away elective in the Department of Radiology, from May 2-27, 2022. The elective is designed for those underrepresented in radiology to gain exposure to the field of oncologic imaging and opportunities within that field, including our own fellowship programs.

## PROGRAM

The applicant will spend a month within the department and will rotate through different sections (body, breast, neuro, IR, molecular imaging, and imaging therapeutics), which will be organized based on their interests and availability. The applicant will be expected to participate in lectures, seminars, and conferences geared toward fellows, observers, and rotating Weill Cornell residents. They will also be assigned a faculty mentor for the month. Travel expenses to New York City as well as a \$2,500 stipend to help cover the cost of housing and living expenses will be provided.

## ELIGIBILITY

This elective is open to all candidates who identify as part of an underrepresented group in medicine and fulfill the requirements of Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. Applicants must also be part of an ACGME-accredited residency program and be in the 2nd year of their radiology residency (PGY-3) in May of 2022.
